

The Digital Theological Library (DTL) provides access to a wide collection of theological, historical, and academic resources.

The DLT provides eBooks and other resources in addition to what is available to Bethany Theological Seminary faculty, staff, and students through Lilly Library.

How to Access the DTL

1. Go to the DTL2 Website: <https://dtl2.libguides.com>

This site provides research help, instructions, and links to all DTL resources.

2. Access the DTL Library Catalog: <https://theologicalreference.on.worldcat.org>

Use this for searching books, e-resources, academic articles, and digital collections.

You may not see a login prompt immediately. You can browse and search without signing in. A login window will appear once you click a resource that requires authentication (eBooks, full-text articles, databases, etc.).

3. Sign In Using Your Bethany Account

When accessing DTL resources, you will see a **login prompt**.

1. Select "Bethany Theological Seminary" under the School drop down.
 - a. Select **Log in with Single Sign-On**

2. Enter your Bethany credentials:
 - a. **Email:** your Bethany email (e.g., usernamebethanyseminary.edu)
 - b. **Password:** your standard Bethany password

- Make sure you are logged out of any personal Microsoft account before signing in.
